- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of veterans' affairs for veterans'
- 2 programs; and to provide for a report to the legislative management.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general 5 fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,490,000, or so much of the 6 sum as may be necessary, to the department of veterans' affairs for the purpose of conducting a 7 veterans' needs assessment and providing healing, therapy, and outreach services to North 8 Dakota veterans, military personnel, their families, and other North Dakota residents suffering 9 from posttraumatic stress disorder, traumatic brain injury, and other neurologic disorders, for the 10 biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows: 11 Therapies and healing services \$900,000 12 North Dakota specific needs assessment \$50,000 13 Regional outreach services \$240,000 14 \$300,000 Leased capital costs 15 Any contract entered or grant awarded by the department of veterans' affairs under this section 16 must include provisions allowing oversight and monitoring and accountability measures and 17 outcome reporting regarding the use of the funds. 18 SECTION 2. SERVICES AND NEEDS ASSESSMENT - REPORT TO LEGISLATIVE 19 **MANAGEMENT.** The department of veterans' affairs shall report <u>quarterly</u> to the legislative 20 management by September 1, 2014, regarding the status of the needs assessment and 21 programs and services provided, including related accountability measures and outcomes, 22 under section 1 of this Act.
