1	A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota
2	Century Code, relating to hunting and fishing fees for disabled veterans.for an Act to create and
3	enact a new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 and a new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of
4	the North Dakota Century Code, relating to disabled veterans and hunting fees; and to amend
5	and reenact subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
6	fishing fees for disabled veterans.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 20.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
and enacted as follows:
Fees for disabled veterans.
Any fee for an individual to hunt or fish under this chapter for a resident disabled veteran is
waived. A disabled veteran is a veteran who has a one hundred percent service-connected
disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or has an extra-schedular rating
to include individual unemployability that brings the veteran's total disability rating to one
hundred percent as determined by the department of veterans' affairs.
SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 20.1-01-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
created and enacted as follows:
"Disabled veteran" means a veteran who has a one hundred percent
service-connected disability as determined by the department of veterans' affairs or
has an extra-schedular rating to include individual unemployability that brings the
veteran's total disability ratio to one hundred percent as determined by the department
of veterans' affairs

Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota

6. For a resident fishing license, ten dollars, except that for a resident sixty-five years or over-or, a resident totally or permanently disabled, or a resident disabled veteran, the license fee is three dollars.

SECTION 3. A new subsection to section 20.1-03-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

For a resident disabled veteran combined general game, habitat stamp, small game, and fur-bearer license, three dollars.
