- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact atwo new sections to chapter 15.1-07 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the provisions of educational services by school districts and
- 3 to the closure of a school.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 6 and enacted as follows:

7 School district - Provision of educational services.

- 8 1. Beginning July 1, 20142015, each school district shall offer educational services to 9 students from kindergarten through grade twelve.
- 10 Any school district that is unable to meet the requirement set forth in subsection 1 2. 11 shall:
- 12 Become reorganized in accordance with chapter 15.1-21.1 by July 1, 20142015; <u>a.</u> 13 or
 - b. Dissolve, in accordance with chapter 15.1-21.1, by July 1, 20142015.
- 15 Notwithstanding any other law, beginning July 1, 20142015, the superintendent of 3. 16 public instruction may not forward state aid payments to a district that does not meet

17 the requirements of subsection 1.

- 18 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 15.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 19 and enacted as follows:
- 20 **Closure of school - Required vote.**

- 21 Before the board of a school district may close a school located within the boundary of a
- 22 district that was required to undergo reorganization or dissolution under section 1 of this Act, the
- 23 board shall place the question of closing the school on the ballot. The question may be voted
- 24 upon only by those qualified electors who reside within the boundary of the district that was

1	required to undergo reorganization or dissolution under section 1 of this Act. The board may	not
1	required to undergo reorganization or dissolution under section 1 of this Act. The board may	1

- 2 close the school unless a majority of the qualified electors voting on the question approve the
- 3 closure.
