- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 16.1-01 and a new section to
- 2 chapter 16.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to emergency authority of the
- 3 secretary of state for the administration of elections.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 16.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

- 7 <u>Secretary of state may postpone election under emergency declaration.</u>
- 8 The secretary of state may postpone an election in part or all of the state for a reasonable
- 9 time if, in a state of disaster or emergency declared by the governor under section 37-17.1-05,
- 10 the state of disaster or emergency is reasonably likely to substantially interfere with the election.
- 11 The period of the postponement of an election may not exceed thirty days from the regularly
- 12 <u>scheduled date of the election. During the state of disaster or emergency, the secretary of state</u>
- 13 may take any action necessary or expedient to facilitate the conduct of the postponed election.
- 14 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 16.1-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

15 and enacted as follows:

16 Emergency procedures to facilitate absentee voting.

- 17 If an international, national, state, or local disaster or emergency or other situation arises
- 18 which makes substantial compliance with the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee

19 Voting Act [42 U.S.C. 1973ff et seq.] impossible or impracticable, as confirmed by the existence

- 20 of armed conflict involving the armed forces of the United States or the mobilization of those
- 21 forces, including national guard and reserve component members of this state, by the
- 22 occurrence of a natural disaster or the existence of a state of emergency, civil unrest, war, or
- 23 <u>other exigency in a foreign country, or by an official declaration by the governor that a state of</u>
- 24 disaster or emergency exists, the secretary of state may prescribe special procedures or

- 1 requirements as may be necessary to facilitate absentee voting by those absent uniformed
- 2 services voters or overseas voters directly affected and who are eligible to vote in this state.
