0	SECTI	ON 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 10 of section 25-03.1-02 of the North Dakota
11	Century Co	ode is amended and reenacted as follows:
2	10. "ľ	Mental health professional" means:
3	а	. A psychologist with at least a master's degree who has been either licensed or
4		approved for exemption by the North Dakota board of psychology examiners.
5	b	. A social worker with a master's degree in social work from an accredited
6		program.
7	С	. A registered nurse with a master's degree in psychiatric and mental health
8		nursing from an accredited program.
9	d	. A registered nurse with a minimum of two years of psychiatric clinical experience
20		under the supervision of a registered nurse as defined by subdivision c or of an

A licensed professional counselor with a master's degree in counseling from an

accredited program who has either successfully completed the advanced training

- beyond the master's degree as required by the national academy of mental
 health counselors or a minimum of two years of clinical experience in a mental
 health agency or setting under the supervision of a psychiatrist or psychologist.
 - g. A licensed marriage and family therapist with a master's degree.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subdivision d of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

d. In the case of benefits provided for outpatient treatment, the benefits must be provided for a minimum of twenty visits for services covered under this section in any calendar year, provided the diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a licensed physician, or a licensed psychologist who is eligible for listing on the national register of health service providers in psychology, or the treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a licensed addiction counselor or a licensed marriage and family therapist. The insurance company, nonprofit health service corporation, or health maintenance organization may not establish a deductible or a copayment for the first five visits in any calendar year, and may not establish a copayment greater than twenty percent for the remaining visits. The deductible limitation of this subdivision does not apply to a high-deductible health plan used to establish a health savings account pursuant to and as defined in section 223 of the Internal Revenue Code [26 U.S.C. 223].

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Paragraph 1 of subdivision f of subsection 2 of section 26.1-36-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

ln the case of benefits provided for outpatient treatment, the benefits must be provided for a minimum of thirty hours for services covered under this section in any calendar year if the treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a nurse who holds advanced licensure with a scope of practice within mental health or if the diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment services are provided within the scope of licensure by a licensed physician, a licensed psychologist who is eligible for listing on the national register of health service providers in psychology, a licensed professional clinical counselor who is qualified in the clinical mental health counseling specialty

3	SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 50-24.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
4	and enacted as follows:
5	Medical assistance - Services provided by marriage and family therapists.
6	The department of human services shall provide medical assistance to eligible recipients for
7	services provided by marriage and family therapists licensed under chapter 43-53.
8	SECTION 5. A new subsection to section 54-44.3-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is
9	created and enacted as follows:
0	Include the profession licensed marriage and family therapist in the North Dakota job
11	classification index classification for advanced clinical specialist.
2	SECTION 6. DEPARTMENT TO SUBMIT AMENDED PLAN. Within thirty days of the
3	effective date of section 4 of this Act, the department of human services shall submit for
4	approval an amended plan to implement section 4 of this Act.
