SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - PENALTIES FOR MINOR DRUG

CRIMES. During the 2013-14 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the sentencing alternatives to incarceration for first-time felony drug offenses that are nonviolent, excluding the distribution of drugs. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fourth legislative assembly.
