1 A concurrent resolution recognizing School Choice Week.

2 **WHEREAS**, every student in this state has a right to the highest-quality schools possible;
3 and

4 **WHEREAS**, citizens across this state agree that improving the quality of education and
5 expanding access to highly effective schools is an issue of importance; and

6 **WHEREAS**, citizens across this state recognize the critical role that an effective and
7 accountable system of education plays in preparing students to be successful adults in a global
8 economy; and

9 **WHEREAS**, this state has a multitude of high-quality public and nonpublic schools; and

10 **WHEREAS**, educational variety not only helps to diversify our economy, but also enhances
11 the vibrancy of our state; and

12 **WHEREAS**, this state has many high-quality teachers in public and private schools who are
13 committed to educating students; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the vital cause of education reform is one that transcends ideology and political
15 affiliation; and

16 **WHEREAS**, research demonstrates conclusively that providing children with multiple
17 schooling options improves academic performance; and

18 **WHEREAS**, School Choice Week is a nationally celebrated event during which legislators
19 and elected officials can join with millions of parents, teachers, schools, and organizations to
20 raise awareness of the need for effective educational options that challenge and motivate all our
21 students to succeed;
