- 2 Century Code, relating to confidentiality of consumer assistance records received by the

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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 26.1-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
6 and enacted as follows:

7	Confidentiality of consumer Consumer assistance records - Exempt.					
8	<u>1.</u>	Personal, financial, or health information related to requests for consumer assistance				
9		received by the commissioner is confidential unless the consumer gives written				
10		permission to release the information except that any such information, including an				
11		individual's social security number, may be used and disclosed:				
12		a. In the administration of any program administered by the commissioner which				
13		provides consumer assistance:				
14		b. As specifically authorized by the rules of the commissioner; or				
15		c. As permitted or required by other lawan exempt record as defined in section				
16		<u>44-04-17.1.</u>				
17	<u>2.</u>	As used in this section, "personal, financial, or health information" means information				
18		collected from or on behalf of an individual requesting consumer assistance which				
19		would reveal:				
20		a. The individual's personal health condition, disease, or injury;				
21		b. The existence, nature, source, or amount of the individual's personal income;				
22		c. The existence, nature, source, or amount of the individual's personal expenses;				
23		d. Records of or relating to the individual's personal financial transactions of any				
24		<u>kind:</u>				

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1		<u>e.</u>	The existence, identification, nature, or value of the individual's personal assets,			
2			liabilities, or net worth;			
3		<u>f.</u>	A history of the individual's personal medical diagnosis or treatment;			
4		<u>g.</u>	The existence, identification, nature, value, or content of the individual's coverage			
5			or status under any insurance policy;			
6		<u>h.</u>	The individual's personal contractual rights or obligations; or			
7		<u>i.</u>	Any social security number, file number, bank account number, or other number			
8			used for identification of the individual or any account in which the individual has			
9			a personal financial interest.			
10	<u>3.</u>	<u>The</u>	name of a regulated entity that is the subject of a complaint or inquiry; is not			
11		"personal, financial, or health information"; and is not subject to the restrictions in this				
12	I	section.				
13	<u> <u>4.    </u></u>	Nothing in this section prohibits the commissioner from using personal, financial, or				
14		health information in the furtherance of any regulatory or legal action brought as a part				
15		of the commissioner's official duties.				
16	<u> <u>5.</u> </u>	This section does not create a private right of action.
