1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the

2 secretary of state and public printing; to provide an exemption exemptions; and to amend and

3 reenact section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code and section 3 of chapter 28 of the

4 2011 Session Laws, relating to the salary of the secretary of state and funding of the mainframe-

5 migration computer project.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds
as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and
other income, to the secretary of state for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
secretary of state and public printing, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending
June 30, 2015, as follows:

6 The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not part of the entity's base budget for the 2015-17
7 biennium. The secretary of state shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-fourth
8 legislative assembly on the use of the one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013,
9 and ending June 30, 2015.

10 SECTION 3. EXEMPTION - GENERAL SERVICES OPERATING FUND. Any unexpended

and unobligated balance remaining in the secretary of state's general services operating fund
on June 30, 2013, is not subject to the provisions of section 54-09-08, and any unexpended

13 funds are available and may be expended by the secretary of state, during the biennium

beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, for the database and processing platformmigration project.

16 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-09-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

17 amended and reenacted as follows:

18 **54-09-05. Salary of secretary of state.**

The annual salary of the secretary of state is <u>ninetyninety-sixninety-five</u> thousand
 three<u>seveneight</u> hundred <u>sixtyninety-foursixty-three</u> dollars through June 30, 20122014, and
 ninety-three<u>one hundred</u>ninety-eight thousand <u>seventy-onesixseven hundred sixty-sixthirty-nine</u>
 dollars thereafter.

23 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 3 of chapter 28 of the 2011 Session Laws is amended 24 and reenacted as follows:

SECTION 3. MAINFRAME MIGRATION COMPUTER PROJECT - FUNDING
 LIMITATION. One-time funding of \$3,500,000 from the general fund for the mainframe migration computer project included in the operating expenses line item of
 subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act may not be used for any other purpose and the
 appropriation authority must be canceled on June 30, 20132015, in accordance with provisions of section 54-44.1-11.

1 **SECTION 5. EXEMPTION - MAINFRAME MIGRATION COMPUTER PROJECT.** 2 Unexpended funding of \$1,750,000 provided in the operating expenses line item of 3 subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 28 of the 2011 Session Laws is not subject to the 4 provisions of section 54-44.1-11 at the end of the 2011-13 biennium and may be continued into 5 the 2013-15 biennium for the completion of the mainframe migration computer project. 6 SECTION 6. NEW FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS - LIMITED AUTHORIZATION. 7 The two new full-time equivalent business registration unit positions and the one new full-time 8 equivalent business information unit position included in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act 9 are authorized only for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015. The 10 secretary of state shall reevaluate these positions after the completion of the mainframe 11 migration computer project to determine if the positions will be requested as part of the agency's 12 2015-17 biennium budget request as optional items.
