## **REENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1005**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state treasurer;
- 2 to amend and reenact subsection 18 of section 54-11-01 and section 54-11-13 of the North

3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the duties and salary of the state treasurer; and to provide

4 legislative intent.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the state treasurer for the purpose of defraying the 9 expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, 10 as follows:

## 19 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

the 2013-15 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

4 The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the

- 5 2015-17 biennium. The state treasurer shall report to the appropriations committees of the
- 6 sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning
- 7 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.
- 8 SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 18 of section 54-11-01 of the North Dakota Century
  9 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 10 18. Shall correct any underpayment, overpayment, or erroneous payment of tax
- 11 distribution funds, resulting from an error made by the state treasurer in a timely
- 12 manner. Unless otherwise provided by law, adjustments may be made from the
- 13 general fund. This authority is limited to one hundred dollars per biennium, unless
- 14 approved by the emergency commission. An adjustment of an insignificant amount
- 15 need not be made at the discretion of the state treasurer. The state treasurer shall
- 16 adopt a written policy identifying what is considered insignificant.
- 17 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-11-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 18 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 **54-11-13. Salary of state treasurer.**
- 20 The annual salary of the state treasurer is eighty-fiveninety thousand three five hundred
- 21 thirtytwenty-seven dollars through June 30, 20122014, and eighty-sevenninety-three thousand
- 22 eight hundred ninetytwo hundred forty-three dollars thereafter.
- SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT STATE TREASURER'S SALARY. It is the intent of
   the sixty-third legislative assembly that the salary of the state treasurer be increased to the
   salary of the next lowest-paid elected official effective July 1, 2017.
