- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state treasurer;
- 2 to amend and reenact subsection 18 of section 54-11-01 and section 54-11-13 of the North
- 3 Dakota Century Code, relating to the duties and salary of the state treasurer; and to provide
- 4 legislative intent; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the state treasurer for the purpose of defraying the 9 expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, 10 as follows:

- 8 The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the
- 9 2015-17 biennium. The state treasurer shall report to the appropriations committees of the
- 10 sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning
- 11 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 18 of section 54-11-01 of the North Dakota Century
Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 14 18. Shall correct any underpayment, overpayment, or erroneous payment of tax
- 15 distribution funds<u>, resulting from an error</u> made by the state treasurer in a timely
- 16 manner. Unless otherwise provided by law, adjustments may be made from the
- 17 general fund. This authority is limited to one hundred dollars per biennium, unless
- 18 approved by the emergency commission. An adjustment of an insignificant amount
- 19 need not be made at the discretion of the state treasurer. The state treasurer shall
- 20 adopt a written policy identifying what is considered insignificant.
- 21 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 54-11-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 22 amended and reenacted as follows:

54-11-13. Salary of state treasurer.

24 The annual salary of the state treasurer is eighty-five<u>ninety</u>ninety-one thousand

25 three<u>five</u>four hundred thirty<u>twenty-seven</u>six dollars through June 30, 20122014, and

26 eighty-seven<u>ninety-threeninety-five</u> thousand eight hundred ninety<u>two hundred forty-</u>

- 27 <u>threesixty-two</u> dollars thereafter.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - STATE TREASURER'S SALARY. It is the intent of the sixty-third legislative assembly that the salary of the state treasurer be increased to the

30 salary of the next lowest-paid elected official effective July 1, 2017.

1 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY. The sum of \$195,223 and one full-time equivalent position

2 included in section 1 of this Act are declared to be an emergency measure.
