1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the tax

2 commissioner and for payment of state reimbursement under the homestead tax credit and

3 disabled veterans credit; to amend and reenact section 57-01-04 of the North Dakota Century

4 Code, relating to the tax commissioner's salary; and to provide for a transfer.

#### 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 9 other income, to the tax commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the tax 10 commissioner and paying the state reimbursement under the homestead tax credit and disabled 11 veterans credit, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015, as follows:

18 The 2013-15 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the

19 2015-17 biennium. The tax commissioner shall report to the appropriations committees of the

20 sixty-fourth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning

21 July 1, 2013, and ending June 30, 2015.

SECTION 3. TRANSFER. There is transferred to the general fund in the state treasury, out
 of motor vehicle fuel tax revenue collected pursuant to section 57-43.1-02, the sum of
 \$1,777,360 for the purpose of reimbursing the general fund for expenses incurred in the
 collection of the motor vehicle fuels and special fuels taxes and the administration of these
 taxes.

# 27 SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 57-01-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 28 amended and reenacted as follows:

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## 1 **57-01-04.** Salary.

- 2 The annual salary of the state tax commissioner is ninety-eightone hundred fivefour
- 3 thousand sixty-eight<u>fifty-one</u>forty dollars through June 30, 20122014, and one hundred
- 4 one<u>nineseven</u> thousand ten<u>two</u>one hundred <u>fifty-three</u>sixty-one dollars thereafter.
