The amendments to Engrossed HB 1009 amend Sections 19-13.1 and 4-01-21 relating to license, inspection, and registration fees, and the agriculture commissioner's salary.

The amendments made the following changes: 1. Section 19-13.1: All fees will be deposited in the environment and rangeland protection fund - estimated to be \$970,000. The funds were previously deposited in the general fund. 2. Section 4-01-21: the agriculture commissioner's salary was restored to the executive budget recommendation. 3. Funding for the Centennial Farm Program was restored to the executive budget recommendation. 4. The Senate restored the compensation and benefit package to the executive budget recommendation. 5. The Senate added spending authority for speciality crop grant - \$625,000. 6. The Senate added general fund authority for desktop support, ND Mediation Service, and livestock auction market news reporting - \$113,000.
