and enacted as follows:

- A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-19 and a new subdivision to subsection 9 of section 43-12.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to medication administration in primary or secondary public schools and exemptions from the nurse practices act.

  BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

  SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 8 Administration of medication Opt-out Liability.
- A teacher or classified staff member who is not employed as a school nurse or
   physician to administer medication may choose to not administer medication under
   section 43-12.1-04.
- 2. An individual authorized to administer medication by section 43-12.1-04 is not civilly or
   criminally liable for any act or omission of that individual when acting in good faith
   while administering medication to a student, except when the conduct amounts to
   gross negligence.
- SECTION 2. A new subdivision to subsection 9 of section 43-12.1-04 of the North Dakota
  Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 18 Within a primary or secondary school if the individual has received education and
  19 training in medication administration and has received written consent of the

20 <u>student's parent or guardian.</u>
