The director shall establish fees for commercial access to statewide base map. Fees collected to be deposited in a new fund, statewide seamless base map maintenance fund and may only be used for maintenance cost of the base map and distributing data. This fund will have a continuing appropriation.

Section 1 does create a fiscal impact for both revenues and expenditures but not until the 2015-17 biennium as completion is anticipated in 2015. Fees have not yet been established, \$100,000 is merely an estimate for 2015-17. The estimated cost of maintaining the base map is approximately \$527,000 per biennium to update 1/3 of the state each biennial period. The appropriation language in Section 1 limits the expenditures to the revenue collected.

Revenues created from commercial access to the base map will be deposited in the statewide seamless base map maintenance fund. Revenues are not included in the 2013-15 executive budget as completion is not anticipated until 2015. Revenues for 2015-17 are estimates.
