## **SENATE BILL NO. 2070**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 19-03.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to immunity from criminal liability for an individual who reports a medical
- 3 emergency involving drugs.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 19-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Overdose prevention and immunity.
- 8 <u>An individual is immune from criminal prosecution under sections 19-03.1-22.1,</u>
- 9 19-03.1-22.3, 19-03.1-22.5, subsection 7 of section 19-03.1-23, subsection 3 of section
- 10 19-03.2-03, and section 19-03.4-03 if that individual contacted law enforcement or emergency
- 11 <u>medical services and reported that the individual was or that another individual was in need of</u>
- 12 emergency medical assistance due to a drug overdose. To receive immunity under this section,
- 13 the state's attorney must find that the individual receiving immunity must have remained on the
- 14 scene until assistance arrived and cooperated with emergency medical services and law
- 15 enforcement personnel in the medical treatment of the reported drug overdosed individual and
- 16 that the overdosed individual was determined to have been in need of emergency medical
- 17 | services. The maximum number of individuals that may be immune for any one occurrence is
- 18 three individuals. Immunity from prosecution under this section is not applicable for a violation
- 19 <u>under section 19-03.1-23.1.</u>
