## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-01-42 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as 6 follows:
- 7 <u>43-41.1-01. Loan Repayment Social Worker Addiction Counselor.</u>
- 1. The state department of health shall administer a student loan repayment program for
   individuals who are:
  - a. Licensed as social workers in accordance with section 43-41-04; or
- b. Licensed as addiction counselors in accordance with section 43-45-05.1.
- 12 <u>2. The state department of health in conjunction with the board of social work examiners</u>
- and board of addiction counseling examiners shall annually identify specific
- 14 geographic areas as underserved. The identification must be based on the number of
- individuals needing services and the number of available full-time positions for
- 16 licensed social workers and licensed addiction counselors in a specified area.
- 17 3. To be eligible for loan forgiveness under this section, an individual must:
- 18 <u>a. Have graduated from an accredited institution of higher education in this state on</u>
  19 <u>or after July 1, 2009;</u>
- 20 <u>b. Have an outstanding student loan;</u>
- 21 <u>c.</u> Be employed full-time by the state or a political subdivision of the state, as a
- 22 <u>social worker or addition counselor, in a geographic area identified as</u>
- 23 underserved: and
- b. Submit an application to the state department of health.

- 4. An eligible individual may receive a maximum loan repayment of six thousand dollars
   per year. An individual may not be awarded more than thirty thousand dollars or loan
   repayment under this section.
  - 5. The state department of health shall consider applications in chronological order.
- 6. Upon verification from the individual's employer that the individual has completed a full
   year of employment in the public sector of an area identified as underserved, the state
   department of health shall distribute funds directly to the Bank of North Dakota to
   repay outstanding loan principal balances for eligible applicants.

**SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$360,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the purpose of providing a loan repayment program for licensed social workers and licensed addiction counselors, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
