- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a school construction assistance loan fund; to amend and reenact
- 3 section 15.1-36-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the approval of school
- 4 construction projects; to provide a continuing appropriation; to provide for a transfer; and to
- 5 provide for a contingent effective date.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-36-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is
 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 15.1-36-01. School construction projects Approval.
 - Notwithstanding the powers and duties of school boards provided by law, the
 superintendent of public instruction shall approve the construction, purchase, repair,
 improvement, modernization, or renovation of any public school building or facility
 before commencement of the project if the cost of the project, as estimated by the
 school board, is in excess of one hundred thousand dollars.
 - 2. The superintendent of public instruction may not approve a project unless the school district proposing the project:
 - Demonstrates the need for the project and the educational utility of the project or demonstrates potential utilization of the project by a future reorganized school district;
 - b. In the case of new construction or a renovation affecting more than fifty percent of an existing structure's square footage, demonstrates that circumstances within the district are likely to result in a stable or increasing Demonstrates that the student population has been stable or has increased during the preceding five
