- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 19-03.4-03 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to drug paraphernalia; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 19-03.4-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 19-03.4-03. Unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia Penalty.
- 7 A person may not use or possess with intent to use drug paraphernalia to plant, 8 propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, 9 process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, or conceal, inject, ingest, 10 inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance in violation 11 of chapter 19-03.1. Any person violating this sectionsubsection is guilty of a class C 12 felony if the drug paraphernalia is used, or possessed with intent to be used, to 13 manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, inject, ingest, 14 inhale, or analyze a controlled substance, other than marijuana, classified in 15 schedule I, II, or III of chapter 19-03.1. Otherwise, a violation of this section is
 - 2. A person may not use or possess with the intent to use drug paraphernalia to inject, ingest, inhale, or otherwise induce into the human body a controlled substance, other than marijuana, classified in schedule I, II, or III of chapter 19-03.1. A person violating this subsection is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- A person may not use or possess with intent to use drug paraphernalia to plant,
 propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce,
 process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, or conceal marijuana in
 violation of chapter 19-03.1. A person violating this subsection is guilty of a class A
 misdemeanor.

- 1 <u>4.</u> A person may not use or possess with the intent to use drug paraphernalia to ingest,
- 2 <u>inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body marijuana in violation of</u>
- 3 <u>chapter 19-03.1. A person violating this subsection is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.</u>
