- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-39.2 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a sales and use tax exemption for clothing; and to provide an effective
- 3 date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 57-39.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

6 and enacted as follows:

7 Sales tax exemption for clothing.

- 8 <u>1.</u> <u>Gross receipts from sales of clothing are exempt from taxes imposed under this</u>
- 9 <u>chapter.</u>
- 10 <u>2.</u> For purposes of this section, "clothing" means all human wearing apparel suitable for
 11 <u>general use.</u>
- 12 <u>3.</u> For purposes of this section, "clothing" includes:

- 14 <u>b.</u> <u>Athletic supporters;</u>
- 15 <u>c.</u> <u>Baby receiving blankets;</u>
- 16 <u>d.</u> <u>Bathing suits and caps;</u>
- 17 <u>e.</u> <u>Beach capes and coats;</u>
- 18 <u>f.</u> <u>Belts and suspenders;</u>
- 19 <u>g.</u> <u>Boots;</u>
- 20 <u>h.</u> <u>Coats and jackets;</u>
- 21 <u>i.</u> <u>Costumes;</u>
- 22 j. Diapers, children and adult, including disposable diapers;
- 23 <u>k.</u> <u>Ear muffs;</u>
