9		section 43-39-05, who is providing athletic training services in accordance with the		
10		individual's education.		
11	2.	"Athletic training" means doing any of the practice of prevention, recognition,		
12		evaluation, management, treatment, and disposition of athletic injuries. The term also-		
13		means rehabilitation of athletic injuries, if under the order of a licensed physician. The		
14		term includes organization and administration of educational programs, athletic-		
15		facilities, and the education and counseling of the publiccomprehensive management		
16		of injuries and illnesses to prevent, clinically evaluate, assess, provide immediate care,		
17		treat, rehabilitate, and recondition.following under the guidance of a physician:		
18		a. Preventing, recognizing, and evaluating injuries and illnesses sustained while		
19		participating in physical activity;		
20		b. Managing and administering the initial treatment of injuries or illnesses sustained		
21		while participating in physical activity;
