1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-59 of the North Dakota

2 Century Code, relating to creation of a health information hub office in the information

3 technology department and a health information hub executive committee; to provide a

4 continuing appropriation; and to provide an appropriation.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-59 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
7 and enacted as follows:

8 Health information hub office - Health information hub executive committee -

9 <u>Continuing appropriation.</u>

- 101.The health information hub office is created in the information technology department.11The health information hub executive committee shall make recommendations to the
- 12 <u>health information hub office for implementing a statewide health information hub that</u>

13 is consistent with emerging national standards for the purpose of facilitating access to

14 <u>and analyzing data to improve health care quality, patient safety, and the overall</u>

15 <u>efficiency of health care and public health services.</u>

162.The health information hub executive committee consists of the state health officer or17the state health officer's designee; the executive director of the department of human

- 18 services or the executive director's designee; the university system chancellor or the
- 19 <u>chancellor's designee; the dean of the university of North Dakota school of medicine</u>
- 20 and health sciences or the dean's designee; the director of the Indian affairs
- 21 <u>commission or the director's designee; the health information technology director or</u>
- 22 the director's designee; the chairman of the house human services standing_
- 23 <u>committee and the chairman of the senate human services standing committee or if</u>
- 24 <u>either or both are unwilling or unable to serve, the chairman of the legislative</u>

1		management	shall appoint a replacement who is a member of the same legislative	
2		<u>chamber as t</u>	ne individual being replaced plus one additional member from each	
3		chamber; a member representing the health council; and individuals appointed by the		
4		governor to represent a broad range of public and private health information		
5		technology st	akeholders. Committee members appointed by the governor serve at the	
6		pleasure of th	e governor. A member of the committee who is not an ex officio member,	
7		designee of a	n ex officio member, state employee, or legislator is entitled to mileage	
8		and expense	s as provided by law for state officers and employees, to be paid by the	
9		health inform	ation hub office. A committee member who is an ex officio member,	
10		designee of a	n ex officio member, state employee, or legislator is entitled to receive	
11		that member'	s regular salary and is entitled to receive mileage and expenses, to be	
12		paid by the e	nploying agency.	
13	<u>3.</u>	The health information hub executive committee shall collaborate with stakeholders to		
14		develop, imp	ement, and operate a statewide health information hub. The committee	
15		shall:		
16		a. <u>Create a</u>	strategic and operational plan;	
17		<u>b. Design,</u>	develop, and implement a process to identify, facilitate access to,	
18		<u>analyze</u>	and distribute health information;	
19		c. Ensure	privacy and security of protected health information; and	
20		d. <u>Ensure</u>	compliance with state and federal laws and regulations regarding health	
21		<u>informat</u>	ion.	
22	<u>4.</u>	<u>The health in</u>	formation hub executive committee shall set policy relating to and shall	
23		recommend t	o the department and the department shall adopt rules relating to the	
24		access to and	the collection, storage, and sharing of information and the systems	
25		necessary to	perform those functions, subject to applicable federal and state privacy	
26		aws and inte	ragency agreements and restrictions relating to confidential information	
27		required to co	onform to applicable federal and state privacy laws. The health	
28		nformation h	ub executive committee shall provide operational oversight for	
29		information sharing activities, make recommendations for, and provide oversight of		
30		information sharing budgets. The committee may authorize studies to benefit and		
31		mprove the c	verall efficiency of health care and public health services.

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1	<u>5.</u>	The health information hub office, in collaboration with the health information hub	
2		executive committee, may solicit and receive moneys from public and private sources	
3		and these funds are appropriated on a continuing basis for the design, development,	
4		implementation, and operation of the health information hub.	
5	<u>6.</u>	The health information hub office shall provide staffing and support services for the	
6		committee and may contract with and employ personnel necessary for the	
7	I	administration of this section.	
8	<u>7.</u>	Any individually identifiable health information, as defined under the federal Health	
9		Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 [Pub. L. 104-191], submitted to,	
10		stored in, or transmitted by the health information hub under this chapter and any such	
11		data or record in the possession of the health information hub office is confidential.	
12		Any other information relating to patients, individuals, or individually identifiable	
13		demographic information contained in the data hub or in the possession of the health	
14		information hub office is an exempt record. Information submitted to, stored in, or	
15		transmitted by the health information hub or health information hub office under this	
16		chapter that identifies individuals or could reasonably be used to identify individuals is	
17		an exempt record under chapter 44-04, unless the information is confidential under	
18		applicable federal or state law.	
19	SEC	CTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general	
20	fund in t	he state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,900,000, or so much of the	
21	sum as may be necessary, to the information technology department to defray the costs of the		
22	health information hub office and the health information hub executive committee, for the		
23	biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. The information technology		
24	department is authorized three full-time equivalent positions for purposes of implementing this		
25	<u>Act.</u>
