- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide student loan repayment programs for health care professionals; to
- 2 repeal chapters 43-12.2 and 43-17.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to student loan
- 3 repayment programs for health care professionals; to provide for a continuing appropriation;
- 4 and to provide for an application.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1**.
- 7 <u>Student loan repayment programs Health care professionals.</u>
- 8 The health council shall administer student loan repayment programs, as established by
- 9 this chapter, for healthcare professionals willing to provide services in areas of this state that
- 10 have a defined need for such services.
- 11 **SECTION 2.**
- 12 **Application process.**
- The health council shall develop an application process for public and private entities
- seeking to fill health care needs and for healthcare professionals willing to provide necessary
- 15 <u>services, including providing medical behavioral health services via telecommunication and</u>
- 16 information technologies, in exchange for benefits under a student loan repayment program.
- 17 SECTION 3.
- 18 Public and private entities Selection criteria Matching funds.
- 19 <u>1. The health council shall establish criteria to be used in selecting public and private</u>
- 20 <u>entities for participation in a program. The criteria must include:</u>
- 21 <u>a. The number of healthcare professionals, by specified field, already providing</u>
- 22 <u>services in the area;</u>
- b. Access to healthcare services in the area; and
