- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 16.1-13-08.1 of the North Dakota Century
- 2 Code, relating to filling vacancies in the office of United States senator and the office of
- 3 representative in Congress; and to repeal section 16.1-13-08 of the North Dakota Century
- 4 Code, relating to filling vacancies in the office of United States senator.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-13-08.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 16.1-13-08.1. Special election to fill a vacancy in the United States <u>Senate and</u> House 9 of Representatives due to a catastrophic circumstance.
- 1. If a vacancy occurs in the office of <u>United States senator or the office of representative</u>
  11 in Congress due to a catastrophic circumstance in which one hundred or more
  12 representatives across the <u>United States are no longer able to servefrom this state</u>
  13 and the next regular or special election is more than seventy-five days in the future,
  14 the governor <u>shall immediately shall</u> issue a writ of election calling a special election to
  15 fill the vacancy. The date of the election <u>shallmust</u> be <u>forty-ninesixty</u> days from the
  16 date of the proclamation and the following deadlines shall apply:
- 17 <del>1. Certificate</del>.
- 2. A certificate of endorsement as described in section 16.1-11-09, affidavitsan affidavit of candidacy described in section 16.1-11-10, and statementsa statement of interestinterests described in section 16.1-09-03 for those candidatesany candidate nominated by a political partiesparty currently established in the state shallmust be filed with the secretary of state by four p.m. on the fortieth fiftieth day before the election.

- 1 2.3. If the election occurs in an election year, the precincts previously established by the county shallmust be utilized.
- 3 3.4. If the election occurs in a year without a scheduled election, the board of county
  4 commissioners mustshall establish the precinct boundaries by the fortieth fiftieth day
  5 before the election.
- The secretary of state shall certify to the county auditors the names of the candidates for the election on the <a href="https://doi.org/10.1007/jhi/html">https://doi.org/10.1007/jhi/html</a> day before the election.
- 8 5.6. Absentee ballots shallmust be made available to qualified electors by the thirtiethforty-fifth day before the election.
- 10 **SECTION 2. REPEAL.** Section 16.1-13-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is repealed.
