- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to supplemental payments for increased school district enrollment.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 15.1-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
and enacted as follows:

6 Supplemental payment - Increased enrollment.

- 7 <u>1.</u> If a school district's September tenth enrollment report indicates that the number of
- 8 <u>students enrolled has increased over the district's average daily membership, as</u>
- 9 determined on the previous June thirtieth, the superintendent of public instruction shall
- 10 add to any other state aid payable to the district in accordance with chapter 15.1-27
- 11 <u>supplemental payment utilizing the difference between the district's average daily</u>
- 12 <u>membership and its fall enrollment.</u>
- <u>13</u> <u>2.</u> <u>The superintendent of public instruction shall apply all pertinent provisions of chapter</u>
 <u>15.1-27 in order to determine the supplemental payment amount.</u>
- 15 3. The superintendent of public instruction shall distribute the payment provided for in
 16 this section to eligible school districts, at the same time and in the same manner as
- 17 <u>other state aid payments.</u>
- 18 <u>4.</u> <u>a.</u> <u>If a school district receives a supplemental payment in accordance with this</u>
- 19 section and if the number of students reflected in the district's September tenth
- 20 <u>enrollment report is greater than the district's average daily membership, as</u>
- 21 determined on the ensuing June thirtieth, the superintendent of public instruction
- 22 shall determine the difference and subtract the amount of dollars attributable to
- 23 that difference from any state aid payment to which the district is entitled during
- 24 <u>the following school year.</u>

1		<u>b.</u>	If a school district receives a supplemental payment in accordance with this
2			section and if the number of students reflected in the district's September tenth
3			enrollment report is less than the district's average daily membership, as
4			determined on the ensuing June thirtieth, the superintendent of public instruction
5			shall determine the difference and add the amount of dollars attributable to that
6			difference to any state aid payment to which the district is entitled during the
7			following school year.
8	<u>5.</u>	<u>A s</u>	chool district may not receive less than the amount to which it was entitled based
9		on	its average daily membership, as determined on the previous June thirtieth.
