- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 54-06-14.5 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to use of state employee sick leave for birth or adoption of a child.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** Section 54-06-14.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

54-06-14.5. Sick leave for birth or adoption of child.

- During the first twelve months following birth or placement, an employer shall grant an employee's request to use sick leave under section 54-06-14 to care for the employee's newborn child or to care for a child placed with the employee, by a child-placing agency licensed under chapter 50-12, for adoption or placed with the employee as a precondition to adoption under section 14-15-12, but not both.
- 2. In the case of an adoption or a placement as a precondition to adoption, the The use of sick leave under this section is limited to the first twelve months of the child living in the employee's home. During any twelve-month period, an employee may not use more than twelvesix weeks of sick leave under this section and the sick leave must conclude within the first twelve months following birth or placement.
- 3. The sick leave required by this section supplements any leave otherwise available to an employee.
