- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 50-24.4-02.350-24.5-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to basic care payment rates; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. Section 50-24.4-02.350-24.5-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

50-24.4-02.350-24.5-02. Basic care payment rates.

- 1. The department shall establish, by rule, procedures for determining rates for the care of residents of basic care facilities that qualify as vendors of an aged, blind, and disabled persons program and for implementing provisions of this chapter. The procedures must be based on methods and standards that the department finds are adequate to recognize the costs that must be incurred for the care of residents in efficiently and economically operated basic care facilities.
- 2. The department shall identify costs that are recognized for establishing payment rates.
- 3. The department shall establish limits on actual allowable historical operating cost per diem based on cost reports of allowable operating costs. For the rate year beginning July 1, 2016, the department annually shall establish limits for cost categories using the costs reports submitted by all participating basic care providers for the report year preceding the rate year. The limits may not fall below the direct care rate established for the ninety-fifth percentile facility and the indirect care rate established for the ninetieth percentile facility.
- 4. The department shall establish, by rule, limitations on compensation recognized in the historical base for top management personnel, prior to allocation, which may not be less than the compensation limit established, by rule, for top management personnel of nursing facilities provided for in section 50-24.4-06.

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
