- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of human services attorney
- 2 general for a human trafficking victims treatment and support services pilot project; and to

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT REPORT. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of human services attorney general for the purpose of implementing a human trafficking victims treatment and support services pilot project for the biennium beginning July 1. 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. As part of the pilot project, the department of humanservices attorney general shall, in consultation with representatives of organizations involved in prevention and treatment services relating to human trafficking, develop a victims treatment and support services model to address the needs of human trafficking victims as defined in section 2 of 2015 Senate Bill No. 2107, including the development and implementation of a statewide protocol for intervention and response methods for professionals, individuals, and state agencies that may encounter human trafficking victims; intervention and prevention methods; emergency or long term crisis centers; residential care; direct care; training for law enforcement, educators, social services providers, foster care providers, health care workers, advocates, court officials, prosecutors, and public defenders; support of advocacy services; and programs promoting positive outcomes for victims. The department of human services attorney general shall report to the legislative management during the 2015-16 interim on the status and results of the pilot project.
