- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to fees for speeding.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 **39-06.1-06. Amount of statutory fees.**
- The fees required for a noncriminal disposition under section 39-06.1-02 or 39-06.1-03 must be as follows:
 - For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of twenty dollars
 except for a violation of any traffic parking regulation on any state charitable or penal
 institution property or on the state capitol grounds, a fee in the amount of five dollars,
 excluding a violation of subsection 10 of section 39-01-15.
- 13 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except for:
- a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, or 39-10-42, a fee of fiftydollars.
- b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 19 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02 or section 39-08-23, a fee of one hundred dollars.
- e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one hundred dollars.

1 A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-04-37 by an individual by becoming a 2 resident of this state, a fee of one hundred dollars. 3 g. A violation of subsection 2 of section 39-10-21.1, a fee of two hundred fifty 4 dollars. 5 A violation of section 39-10-59, a fee of one hundred dollars. h. 6 İ. On a highway on which the speed limit is a speed higher than fifty-five miles-25 [88.51 kilometers] an hour, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or an equivalent-26 ordinance, a fee established as follows: 27 Miles per hour over 28 lawful speed limit Fee 29 1 - 10 \$2/each mph over limit 30 11 + \$20 plus \$5/each mph over 10 mph over limit 31 For a violation of subsection 3 of section 39-21-46, a fee established as follows:

1 Driving more than eleven hours since the last ten hours off duty, driving after 2 fourteen hours on duty since the last ten hours off duty, driving after sixty hours 3 on duty in seven days or seventy hours in eight days, no record of duty status or 4 log book in possession, failing to retain previous seven-day record of duty status 5 or log book, or operating a vehicle with four to six out-of-service defects, one 6 hundred dollars: 7 False record of duty status or log book or operating a vehicle with seven to nine b. 8 out-of-service defects, two hundred fifty dollars: 9 Operating a vehicle after driver placed out of service, operating a vehicle with ten C. 10 or more out-of-service defects, or operating a vehicle that has been placed out of 11 service prior to its repair, five hundred dollars; and 12 d. All other violations of motor carrier safety rules adopted under subsection 3 of 13 section 39-21-46, fifty dollars. 14 7.6. On a highway on which the speed limit is posted in excess of sixty-five fifty-five miles 15 [104.6188.51 kilometers] an hour, but lower than seventy miles [112.65 kilometers] an 16 hour, for a violation of section 39-09-02, or equivalent ordinance, a fee of fivefour-17 dollars for each mile peran hour over the limit. On a highway on which the speed limit 18 is posted at seventy miles [112.65 kilometers] an hour or higher, for a violation of 19 section 39-09-02, or equivalent ordinance, a fee of five dollars for each mile an hour-20 over the limit. 21 -8.7. For a violation of a school zone speed limit under subdivision b of subsection 1 of 22 section 39-09-02, a fee of fortyeighty dollars for one through ten miles peran hour over 23 the posted speed; and fortyeighty dollars, plus onetwo dollar for each additional mile 24 peran hour over ten miles per hour over the limit unless a greater fee would be 25 applicable under this section. 26 9.8.7. For a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of 27 section 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles peran hour over the 28 posted speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile peran hour over ten 29 miles per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this

section. The fee in this subsection does not apply to a highway construction zone
