1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-22-26 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to motor vehicle brokers; and to provide a penalty.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-22-26 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-22-26. Brokering of motor vehicles prohibited - Penalty.**

- 7 A person may not act as, offer to act as, or hold out to be a motor vehicle broker. As used in-
- 8 this section, a broker is a person who, for a fee, commission, or other valuable consideration,-
- 9 arranges or offers to arrange a transaction involving the sale or exchange of a motor vehicle,-
- 10 and who is not:
- 11 1. A dealer or a bona fide agent or employee of a dealer;
- 12 2. A representative or a bona fide agent or employee of a manufacturer;
- 13 3. The bona fide owner of the motor vehicle involved in the transaction; or
- 14 4. A bona fide auctioneer conducting an auction involving motor vehicles not owned by
- 15 the auctioneer.
- 16 Any person violating this section is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 17 <u>1.</u> <u>A motor vehicle broker shall provide each buyer or lessee with a written disclosure</u>
- 18 stating whether the motor vehicle broker receives a fee from the dealers with whom
- 19 the broker does business. The new or used motor vehicle dealer is the seller of record
- 20 <u>in all transactions. The motor vehicle dealer may pay the motor vehicle broker a fee for</u>
- 21 brokering services rendered. A motor vehicle broker may:
- 22a.Advertise and solicit the brokering of new motor vehicles. A motor vehicle broker23may not advertise or make any representations that state, imply, or suggest that
- 24 the motor vehicle broker sells vehicles, is authorized to sell vehicles, or obtains

1			vehicles directly from the motor vehicle manufacturer. All advertising or other
2			solicitations by a motor vehicle broker must disclose that sales of new motor
3			vehicles are arranged through franchised motor vehicle dealers;
4		<u>b.</u>	Negotiate or quote the sale price or lease terms of motor vehicles;
5		<u>C.</u>	Prepare and deliver documents necessary to the transaction;
6		<u>d.</u>	Accept a down payment not to exceed six percent of the expected purchase price
7			of the vehicle or five hundred dollars, whichever is greater, but otherwise may not
8			accept payment in full or in part for a motor vehicle unless the payment is in the
9			form of a negotiable instrument payable to the vehicle dealer;
10		<u>e.</u>	Keep the portion of a down payment in the amount of expenses incurred by the
11			broker even if the broker does not arrange for a vehicle;
12		<u>f.</u>	Accompany a motor vehicle purchaser or lessee at the time of delivery by the
13			selling dealer of a new motor vehicle; and
14		<u>g.</u>	Be present when warranties and safety features are described by the selling
15			dealer in conjunction with the delivery of a new motor vehicle.
16	<u>2.</u>	A motor vehicle broker may not:	
17		<u>a.</u>	Engage in the business of selling new or used motor vehicles;
18		<u>b.</u>	Execute contracts or official documents for the sale or lease of a new motor
19			vehicle;
20		<u>C.</u>	Describe a new vehicle's warranties or safety features in conjunction with the
21			delivery of a new motor vehicle;
22		<u>d.</u>	Display motor vehicles available for sale or lease; or
23		<u>e.</u>	Perform any dealer preparation of new motor vehicles.
24	<u>3.</u>	<u>Thi</u>	s section does not apply to licensed motor vehicle lessors and may not be
25		<u>con</u>	strued to restrict licensed motor vehicle lessors from brokering motor vehicle
26		leas	ses or otherwise engaging in the leasing of motor vehicles.
27	<u>4.</u>	<u>As</u>	used in this section, a "motor vehicle broker" is a person who, for a fee,
28		commission, or other valuable consideration, arranges or offers to arrange a	
29		transaction involving the lease, sale, or exchange of a motor vehicle, and who is not:	
30		<u>a.</u>	A dealer or a bona fide agent or employee of a dealer;
31		<u>b.</u>	A representative or a bona fide agent or employee of a manufacturer;

- 1 <u>c.</u> <u>The bona fide owner of the motor vehicle involved in the transaction; or</u>
- 2 <u>d.</u> <u>A bona fide auctioneer conducting an auction involving motor vehicles not owned</u>
- 3 by the auctioneer.
- 4 <u>5.</u> <u>A person violating this section is guilty of an infraction.</u>
