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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-16-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as 6 follows:

## Treatment of victims of sexual assault.

- 8 <u>1. As used in this section:</u>
  - a. "Hospital" means an entity required to obtain a license under section 23-16-01.
- b. "Sexual assault" has the same meaning as provided under section 12.1-20-07.
- 11 <u>c. "Victim of sexual assault" means an individual who:</u>
- 12 (1) States a sexual assault has been committed against the individual;
- 13 (2) <u>Is accompanied by another individual who states a sexual assault has been</u>

  14 <u>committed against the accompanied individual; or</u>
  - (3) An individual who hospital personnel or a sexual assault nurse examiner have reason to believe is a victim of sexual assault.
  - A hospital may not require a victim of sexual assault to submit to a forensic examination or to report the alleged sexual assault to law enforcement.
- A hospital without staff specially trained to perform a sexual assault forensic
   examination may coordinate with a community-based sexual assault nurse examiner
   nurse program or develop a sexual assault examiner nurse program to ensure all
   victims of sexual assault who want a sexual assault forensic examination or sexually
   transmitted infection treatment receive that examination or treatment.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the gener	al

much of the sum as may be necessary, to the state department of health for the division of

this section shall use the grant funds to train and support a sexual assault nurse examiner	
program.
