1	A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 5-01-22 of the North Dakota Century Code,
2	relating to the prohibition of powdered alcohol products.for an Act to amend and reenact
3	subsection 2 of section 5-01-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of
4	alcohol.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
6	SECTION 1. Section 5-01-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as
7	<del>follows:</del>
8	5-01-22. Powdered alcohol products prohibited - Penalty - Exceptions.
9	1. As used in this section, "powdered alcohol product" means any alcohol prepared or
10	sold in a powder form for either direct use or reconstitution in a liquid beverage or
11	<del>food.</del>
12	2. A person may not sell, offer to sell, purchase, offer to purchase, possess, or consume
13	a powdered alcohol product.
14	3. A violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor.
15	4. This section does not apply to the use of powdered alcohol products by a:
16	a. Health care provider that operates primarily for the purpose of conducting
17	scientific research;
18	<u>b.</u> <u>State institution;</u>
19	<u>c.</u> Private college or university; or
20	d. Pharmaceutical or biotechnology company.
21	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 5-01-01 of the North Dakota Century
22	Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
23	2. "Alcoholic beverages" means any liquidsubstance suitable for drinkingingestion by

human beings, which contains one-half of one percent or more of alcohol by volume.
