- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 16.1-16 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to audits of ballots and voting equipment.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 16.1-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Ballot and voting equipment audit Election contest.
- 7 Upon request and deposit of a bond in an amount established by the county auditor which
- 8 is sufficient to pay the cost of the audit, a qualified elector of a county may request an audit of
- 9 all ballots and voting equipment used at any election in the county. The request must be filed
- 10 within five days after final certification of a recount by the appropriate canvassing board or
- 11 within fourteen days after the final certification by the appropriate canvassing board if no
- 12 recount was conducted. The audit must account for all ballots delivered to polling places and
- mailed to applicants for absent voters' ballots or all ballots mailed under chapter 16.1-11.1. If the
- 14 results of the audit indicate irregularities in ballot counts which are at least equal to fifty percent
- 15 of the margin of victory in any election contest in the county, a candidate from any such contest
- within that margin of victory may file a request with the district court to have the election or
- 17 nomination of the winning candidate or candidates voided and to direct a new election. The
- 18 request to have an election voided must be made in the same manner as an election contest
- 19 under this chapter and must be filed with the district court within fourteen days after the audit is
- 20 completed.
