1	A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 5 of article IV of the Constitution of North
2	Dakota, relating to residency requirements of members of the legislative assembly.directing the
3	Legislative Management to study the residency requirements of members of the Legislative
4	Assembly.
5	STATEMENT OF INTENT
6	This measure would require a member of the legislative assembly to be a resident of the district
7	from which selected.
8	WHEREAS, North Dakota Century Code Section 44-02-01 provides that an office becomes
9	vacant if the incumbent ceases to be a resident of the state, district, county, or other political
10	subdivision in which the duties of the office are to be discharged, or for which the individual may
11	have been elected; and
12	WHEREAS, questions have arisen regarding the statutory provision and how it applies to
13	members of the Legislative Assembly;
14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE HOUSE OF
15	REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
17	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
18	 — That the following proposed amendment to section 5 of article IV of the Constitution of
19	North Dakota is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the
20	primary election to be held in 2016, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the
21	Constitution of North Dakota.

24	 Section 5. Each person elected tomember of the legislative assembly must be, on the day
25	of the electionduring the entire term for which selected, a qualified elector in the district from-

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- 1 which the member was chosen<u>selected</u> and must have been a resident of the state for one year
- 2 immediately prior to that electionselection to the legislative assembly. Each house of the
- 3 <u>legislative assembly shall adopt rules regarding confirmation and verification of the</u>
- 4 <u>qualifications, as required under this section, of its members throughout the term for which</u>
- 5 <u>elected</u>.
- 6 That the Legislative Management study the residency requirements of members of the
- 7 Legislative Assembly; and
- 8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 9 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 10 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
