- 1 A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 23 of article I of the Constitution of North
- 2 Dakota, relating to the rejection of unconstitutional federal actions.

3 STATEMENT OF INTENT

- 4 This measure would allow the state to exercise its sovereign authority by restricting state and
- 5 local government personnel and financial resources to purposes that are consistent with the
- 6 Constitution of the United States.
- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE
- 8 SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 9 That the proposed amendment to section 23 of article I of the Constitution of North Dakota
- 10 is agreed to and must be submitted to the qualified electors of North Dakota at the general
- 11 election to be held in 2016, in accordance with section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of
- 12 North Dakota.
- 13 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 23 of article I of the Constitution of North Dakota is
- 14 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 15 **Section 23**.
- 16 1. The state of North Dakota is an inseparable part of the American union and the
- 17 Constitution of the United States is the supreme law of the land to which all
- 18 government, state and federal, is subject.
- 19 <u>2.</u> To protect the people's freedom and to preserve the checks and balances of the
- 20 <u>Constitution of the United States, this state may exercise its sovereign authority to</u>
- 21 restrict the actions of its personnel and the use of its financial resources to purposes
- 22 that are consistent with the Constitution of the United States by:
- 23 <u>a. Passage of an initiative or referendum pursuant to section 1 of article III;</u>
- 24 <u>b. A law enacted by the legislative assembly; or</u>
- 25 <u>c. Pursuing any other available legal remedy.</u>

- 3. If the people or the legislative assembly exercise authority pursuant to this section, this
 state and all political subdivisions are prohibited from using any personnel or financial
- 3 resources to enforce, administer, or cooperate with the designated federal action or
- 4 <u>program</u>.
