

**HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3044**

Introduced by

1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study the pay-it-forward model  
2 of funding higher education.

3 **WHEREAS**, college affordability has emerged as a central issue for state and federal  
4 policymakers; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the inadequate funding of higher education has over time shifted greater  
6 amounts of the college financing burden to students and their parents; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the combination of high tuition rates and high fees has resulted in record  
8 student debt levels and overarching concerns that a college education is becoming out of reach  
9 for students from low-income and middle-income families; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the urgency to find bold policy solutions for higher education affordability has  
11 generated options such as the pay-it-forward model; and

12 **WHEREAS**, under a pay-it-forward model of funding higher education, a student is  
13 permitted to pursue a degree or diploma without incurring tuition costs, provided the student  
14 agrees to pay back a small percentage of the student's income for a period of approximately  
15 twenty years; and

16 **WHEREAS**, under a pay-it-forward model of funding higher education, a graduate's  
17 repayment would be proportionate to the graduate's income; and

18 **WHEREAS**, a pay-it-forward model is not a sole solution to all higher education debt, it  
19 could address many of the existing concerns and further open doors of opportunity within higher  
20 education for students from low-income and middle-income families;

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**  
22 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

23 That the Legislative Management study the pay-it-forward model of funding higher  
24 education, including the potential benefits for students of this state, any administrative changes

- 1 that would be necessitated by implementation of the model, and the short-term and longer term
- 2 viability of the model; and
- 3 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
- 4 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
- 5 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
