1 A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to study all policies, procedures,
2 supports, and services available at all public institutions of higher education in the state
3 regarding sexual assault and related incidents.

4 **WHEREAS**, there have been a number of significant incidents garnering negative media
5 attention regarding sexual assault on campuses across the country; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the reporting procedures for students who have experienced a sexual assault
7 vary on each campus; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the services and supports available to victims of sexual assault vary greatly on
9 each campus; and

10 **WHEREAS**, recent reports have indicated that our universities and colleges may have
11 deficiencies in the policies regarding sexual assault reporting and services available for
12 students;

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**
14 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

15 That the Legislative Management study all policies, procedures, supports, and services
16 available at all public institutions of higher education in the state regarding sexual assault and
17 related incidents; and

18 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
19 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
20 the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.
