2 System and State Board of Higher Education to study all policies, procedures, supports, and
3 services available at all public institutions of higher education in the state regarding sexual
4 assault and related incidents.

5 **WHEREAS**, there have been a number of significant incidents garnering negative media
6 attention regarding sexual assault on campuses across the country; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the reporting procedures for students who have experienced a sexual assault
8 vary on each campus; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the services and supports available to victims of sexual assault vary greatly on
10 each campus; and

11 **WHEREAS**, recent reports have indicated that our universities and colleges may have
12 deficiencies in the policies regarding sexual assault reporting and services available for
13 students;

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**
15 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

16 That the ~~Legislative Management study all policies, procedures, supports, and services~~
17 ~~available at all public institutions of higher education in the state regarding sexual assault and~~

19 ~~—BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Management report its findings and~~
20 ~~recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to~~
21 ~~the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly.~~North Dakota Legislative Assembly recognizes the need to
22 address policies regarding sexual assault reporting and services available to students and
23 urges the North Dakota University System and the State Board of Higher Education to study the
