BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. BOND ISSUANCE AUTHORIZATION - PURPOSES. The state board of higher education, in accordance with chapter 15-55, may arrange for the funding of the project authorized in this section, declared to be in the public interest, through the issuance of self-liquidating, tax-exempt evidences of indebtedness under chapter 15-55, beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2017. Evidences of indebtedness issued pursuant to this section are not general obligation of the state of North Dakota. Any unexpended balanceresulting from the proceeds of the evidences of indebtedness must be placed in a sinking fundto be used for the retirement of indebtedness. The evidences of indebtedness may be issued and the proceeds are appropriated in section 2 of this Act for the following capital project: Dickinson state university - Woods Hall \$6,100,000 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from federal funds and otherincome, to Dickinson state university under the supervision of the state board of highereducation for the purpose of defraying the expenses of improvements to Woods Hall beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2017, as follows: Capital assets \$7,500,000 \$7,500,000 Total special funds SECTION 3. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - DICKINSON STATE UNIVERSITY
STUDENT HOUSING. During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall consider
studying the feasibility and desirability of renovating of Woods Hall and purchasing other
properties for student housing near Dickinson state university. If conducted, the study must
consider enrollment trends, student housing need, the university system master plan and space
utilization study, ability to repay debt incurred for the purchase, and anticipated deferred
maintenance costs. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations,
together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fifth
legislative assembly.
