PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1022

That the Senate recede from its amendments as printed on pages 1299-1301of the House Journal and pages 1036 and 1037 of the Senate Journal and that Engrossed House Bill No. 1021 be amended as follows:

Page 1, line 2, after "indigents" insert "; to amend and reenact subsection 6 of section 54-61-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the commission on legal counsel for indigents; and to provide for a report to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly"

Page 1, replace lines 12 and 13 with:

Page 1, replace lines 15 through 17	with:

Page 1, after line 18, insert:

"SECTION 2. STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND - CONTRACT SERVICE FEES. The commission on legal counsel for indigents line item in section 1 of this Act, includes the sum of \$200,000 from the strategic investment and improvements fund for contract service fees. The funding provided is considered a one-time funding item.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 6 of section 54-61-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

6. A member of the commission is entitled to reimbursement for travel and expenses as provided by law for other state officers. If not otherwise employed by the state of North Dakota, a member is entitled to receive per diem compensation of sixty-two dollars and fifty cents for each day devoted to attending meetings or performing other duties relating to the official business of the commission. A member of the commission who is a member of the legislative assembly is entitled to receive per diem compensation at the rate as provided under section 54-35-10 for each day devoted to attending meetings or performing other duties relating to the official business of the commission. The legislative council shall pay the per diem compensation and reimbursement for travel and expenses as provided by law for any member of the commission who is a member of the legislative assembly.

SECTION 4. ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICES - REPORT TO SIXTY-FIFTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The commission on legal counsel for indigents shall report to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly regarding the effectiveness of limits and procedures used to ensure that defense services are provided only to indigent clients."

This amendment also adds:

- An amendment to North Dakota Century Code Section 54-61-01, which provides a member of
 the Commission on Legal Counsel for Indigents who is also a legislator is entitled to receive per
 diem compensation as provided under Section 54-35-10. The Legislative Council is required to
 pay the per diem and travel and related expenses for the legislators. The Senate added the
 section but did not require the Legislative Council to pay the per diem and travel and expenses
 for the legislators.
- A new section requiring the agency to report to the 65th Legislative Assembly regarding the
 effectiveness of limits and procedures to provide defense services to only those individuals who
 are indigent.
- A new section providing one-time funding of \$200,000 from the strategic investment and improvements fund for contract fee services.

¹ Funding for employee health insurance premiums is adjusted to reflect the revised premium estimate of \$1,130.22 per month.

² One-time funding is added for contract fees for legal services related to increasing case loads from the strategic investment and improvements fund to provide a total of \$4.4 million. The Senate provided \$200,000 for these fees from the general fund.
