- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public service
- 2 commission; to amend and reenact section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the salary of public service commissioners; and to authorize a transfer.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the public service commission for the purpose of defraying the expenses of

9 that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

- 2 SIXTY-FIFTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding
- 3 items approved by the sixty-third legislative assembly for the 2013-15 biennium and the
- 4 2015-17 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

- 12 The 2015-17 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the
- 13 2017-19 biennium. The public service commission shall report to the appropriations committees
- 14 of the sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium
- 15 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
- SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 49-01-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

18 **49-01-05. Salary of commissioners.**

- The annual salary of a commissioner is ninety-nine thousand four hundred thirty-five dollars through June 30, 2014, and one hundred two thousand four hundred eighteen one hundred six thousand five hundred fifteen dollars through June 30, 2016, and one hundred ten thousand seven hundred seventy-five dollars thereafter. All fees received or charged by any commissioner for any act or service rendered in any official capacity must be accounted for and
- paid over by the commissioner monthly to the state treasurer and must be credited to the
- 25 general fund of the state.

26 SECTION 4. TRANSFER AND REPAYMENT - BEGINNING FARMER REVOLVING LOAN

- **FUND.** The Bank of North Dakota shall transfer from the beginning farmer revolving loan fund to
- 28 the public service commission the sum of \$900,000, or so much of the sum as may be
- 29 necessary, included in the estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act to pay for costs
- 30 associated with a rail rate complaint case. Transfers must be made during the biennium
- 31 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, upon order of the commission. If any

- 1 amounts are spent pursuant to this section, the public service commission shall reimburse the
- 2 beginning farmer revolving loan fund using amounts available from damages or proceeds
- 3 received, net of legal fees, from a successful outcome of a rail complaint case.
