The railroad safety program line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$972,294 from the rail safety fund, of which \$762,294 relates to salaries and wages and \$210,000 relates to operating expenses for the public service commission to establish and operate a state railroad safety program for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017."

All taxes, license fees, penalties, and interest collected under this chapter must be transferred to the state treasurer who shall deposit moneys in a highway tax distribution fund, except all special fuels excise taxes collected on sales of diesel fuel to a railroad under section 57-43.2-03 of up to two hundred fifty thousand dollars per year must be transferred to the state treasurer who shall deposit the moneys in the highway-rail grade crossing safety projects fund. The highway tax distribution fund must be distributed in the manner as prescribed by section 54-27-19.

(Effective after June 30, 2015) Transfer, deposit, and distribution of funds. All taxes, license fees, penalties, and interest collected under this chapter must be transferred to the state treasurer who shall deposit moneys in a highway tax distribution fund, except all special fuels excise taxes collected on sales of diesel fuel to a railroad under section 57-43.2-03 of up to five hundred thousand dollars per year must be transferred to the state treasurer who shall deposit the moneys in the rail safety fund. The highway tax distribution fund must be distributed in the manner as prescribed by section 54-27-19.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. Section 6 of this Act is effective for special fuels excise taxes collected after June 30, 2015.

SECTION 8. RETROACTIVE APPLICATION. The specialized legal services line item in section 1 of this Act is retroactive in application.

SECTION 9. EMERGENCY. The specialized legal services line item in section 1 of this Act is declared to be an emergency measure."

- Designates that of the railroad safety program line item in Section 1 of the bill, \$972,294 is from the rail safety fund, of which \$762,294 relates to salaries and wages and \$210,000 relates to operating expenses for the Public Service Commission for creating a state railroad safety program.
- Amends Section 3 of the bill to provide 3 percent annual salary increases for the commissioners during the 2015-17 biennium.
- Creates the rail safety fund and amends North Dakota Century Code Section 57-43.2-19 to allocate special fuels excise taxes collected on sales of diesel fuel to a railroad under Section 57-43.2-03 of up to \$500,000 per year from the highway tax distribution fund to the rail safety fund.
- Provides an effective date for special fuels excise taxes collected after June 30, 2015.
- Provides a retroactive application for the specialized legal services line item.
- Declares the specialized legal services line item to be an emergency measure.
