## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

## 1 SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO 2 SIXTY-FIFTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the 2015-17 one-time 3 funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act: 4 One-Time Funding Description 2013-15 <u>2015-17</u> 5 National genomics center \$0 \$800,000 6 Information technology analysis 0 150,222 7 0 Department website redesign 100,000 8 \$0 Total general fund \$1,050,222 9 The 2015-17 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 10 2017-19 biennium. The agriculture commissioner shall report to the appropriations committees 11 of the sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium 12 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 13 SECTION 3. TRANSFER - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND -14 MINOR USE PESTICIDE FUND. The agriculture commissioner shall transfer \$325,000 from the 15 environment and rangeland protection fund to the minor use pesticide fund during the biennium 16 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 17 SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION 18 **FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,403,714, 19 or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the environment and rangeland protection 20 fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various department of agriculture programs. 21 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 22 SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAME AND FISH FUND. The estimated income line 23 item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$499,585, or so much of the sum as may be 24 necessary, from the game and fish department operating fund for the purpose of defraying the 25 expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 26 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 27 SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STATE WATER COMMISSION - TRANSFER. The 28 estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000 which the state

water commission shall transfer to the agriculture commissioner for the wildlife services

program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

1 SECTION 7. WATERBANK PROGRAM - MATCHING FUNDS. The salaries and wages line 2 item in section 1 of this Act includes \$50,000 from the general fund for matching funds for the 3 North Dakota outdoor heritage fund grant provided for the waterbank program. 4 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended 5 and reenacted as follows: 6 4-01-21. Salary of agriculture commissioner. 7 The annual salary of the agriculture commissioner is ninety-nine thousand four hundred-8 thirty-five dollars through June 30, 2014, and one hundred two thousand four hundred 9 eighteenone hundred five thousand four hundred ninety-one dollars through June 30, 2016, and 10 one hundred eight thousand six hundred fifty-six dollars thereafter. 11 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY. The sum of \$100,000 of federal funds included in the state 12 board of animal health line item in section 1 of this Act is declared to be an emergency 13 measure.
