- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the insurance
- 2 commissioner; to provide an appropriation for the distribution of funds from the insurance tax
- 3 distribution fund; and to amend and reenact section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century
- 4 Code, relating to the commissioner's salary.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

1	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the insurance
2	tax distribution fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$16,701,207 or
3	so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the insurance commissioner for the purpose of
4	providing payments, in accordance with provisions of section 18-04-05, to North Dakota fire
5	departments in the amount of \$15,681,207, and payments to the North Dakota firefighter's
6	association in the amount of \$1,020,000, of which, \$130,000 is one-time funds, for the biennium
7	beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
8	SECTION 3. BONDING FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes \$43,451\\$50,813 from the
9	state bonding fund to pay bonding fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July
10	1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
11	SECTION 4. FIRE AND TORNADO FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes
12	\$1,469,026\$1,660,748 from the state fire and tornado fund to pay fire and tornado fund
13	administrative expenses, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
14	SECTION 5. UNSATISFIED JUDGMENT FUND. Section 1 of this Act includes
15	\$30,048\$29,062 from the state unsatisfied judgment fund to pay unsatisfied judgment fund
16	administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
17	SECTION 6. PETROLEUM RELEASE COMPENSATION FUND. Section 1 of this Act
18	includes \$104,269\subseteq116,881 from the petroleum release compensation fund to pay petroleum
19	release compensation fund administrative expenses for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015,
20	and ending June 30, 2017.
21	SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-01-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
22	amended and reenacted as follows:
23	26.1-01-09. Salary of commissioner.
24	The annual salary of the commissioner is ninety-six thousand seven hundred ninety-four-
25	dollars through June 30, 2014, and ninety-nine thousand six hundred ninety-eightone hundred
26	three thousand six hundred eighty-sixone hundred two thousand six hundred eighty-nine dollars
27	through June 30, 2016, and one hundred seven thousand eight hundred thirty-three one
28	hundred five thousand seven hundred seventy dollars thereafter.
