4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 43-45-01 of the North Dakota Century
- 6 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- "Addiction counseling" means the provision of counseling or assessment of
 personsindividuals regarding their use or abuse of alcohol or a controlled other harmful
 substance or their behavioral addiction.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 43-45-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 12 43-45-06. Addiction counseling practice Exemptions.
- 1. Nothing in this This chapter may be construed to does not prevent any person from doing work within the standards and ethics of that person's profession and calling, provided if that the person does not represent to the public, by title or by use of the initials L.A.C., that the person is engaging in addiction counseling.
- Nothing in this This chapter may be construed to does not prevent addiction counseling
 trainees or interns in board-approved programs from engaging in addiction counseling
 related to training.
- An individual licensed by the state board of psychologist examiners under chapter
 43-32, North Dakota board of social work examiners under chapter 43-41, board of
 counselor examiners under chapter 43-47, or marriage and family therapy licensure
 board under chapter 43-53 may conduct addiction counseling, unless otherwise
- 24 <u>prohibited or limited by the individual's licensing board.</u>
