- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact chapter 43-12.4 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 providing for a nursing faculty student loan repayment program; and to amend and reenact
- 3 sections 43-12.3-03 and 43-12.3-06 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the health
- 4 care professional student loan repayment program.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-12.3-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 43-12.3-03. Public and private entities Selection criteria Matching funds.
- The health council shall establish criteria to be used in selecting public and private
   entities for participation in a program. The criteria must include:
  - a. The number of health care professionals, by specified field, already providing services in the area;
  - b. Access to health care services in the area; and
  - c. The level of support from the area.
- The health council may consult with health care and social service providers,
   advocacy groups, governmental entities, and others in establishing criteria and
   evaluating needs based on the criteria.
  - AnExcept as otherwise provided under this chapter, an entity may not be selected for participation unless it contractually commits to provide matching funds equal to the amount required for a loan repayment program in accordance with section 43-12.3-06.
- 21 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-12.3-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

Student loan repayment program - Nursing faculty. 23 The health council shall administer a student loan repayment program established under 24 this chapter for a member of a nursing faculty who advances that faculty member's education 25 through a master's degree or doctorate degree. Subject to legislative appropriation, an award 26 under this chapter may not exceed the lesser of ten thousand dollars or the total sum of 27 educational loans incurred to pursue the advanced degree. 28 43-12.4-02. Selection criteria. 29 The health council shall establish criteria to be used in selecting qualified applicants 1. 30 for the nursing faculty student loan repayment program. The criteria must include:

- Payments under this chapter terminate upon the earlier of four years or failure of the
   applicant to meet the terms of the contract.
  - If a qualified applicant receiving payments under this chapter breaches the student loan repayment program contract by failing to timely complete the advanced degree, failing to maintain full-time employment as a nursing program faculty member at an institution of higher education located in this state during the pursuit of the advanced degree or for four years following receipt of the advanced degree, or failing to provide the health council with necessary verification, the applicant is liable for the full amount of any loan repayment funds received. Any damages the state is entitled to recover under this chapter must be paid to the health council within one year from the date of the breach. Damages recoverable for a breach of the contract include all interest, costs, and expenses incurred in collection, including attorney's fees. The health council shall deposit in the state general fund any damages collected under this section. The health council may agree to accept a lesser measure of damages for breach of a loan repayment program contract if compelling reasons are demonstrated, including death of the applicant, a certifiable medical condition or disability, or a call to military service.

## 43-12.4-04. Payments.

Annually, upon receipt of verification of continued eligibility, the health council shall make a payment to the qualified applicant as provided under the terms of the contract. The health council shall make payments directly to the qualified applicant.
