BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-17-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 54-17-02. Industrial commission Members Quorum Meetings.
 - The industrial commission of North Dakota shall consists of the governor, the attorney general, and the agriculture commissioner, the tax commissioner, and the chairman of the public service commission. The governor and one membertwo members constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. The meetings of the commission must be held at such times and places as the governor or a majority of the commission may determine. It The commission must be provided by the proper authorities with suitably furnished offices at the seat of government.

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 28-32-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

2. "Administrative agency" or "agency" means each board, bureau, commission, department, or other administrative unit of the executive branch of state government, including one or more officers, employees, or other persons directly or indirectly purporting to act on behalf or under authority of the agency. An administrative unit located within or subordinate to an administrative agency must be treated as part of that agency to the extent it purports to exercise authority subject to this chapter. The term administrative agency does not include:
