- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a study on the impact of the Fargo diversion project.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:
- 3 **SECTION 1**.
- 4 <u>State water commission study of Fargo diversion project.</u>
- 5 During the 2015-16 interim, the state water commission shall contract for a with North
- 6 Dakota state university to expand the scope of the university's existing study of the impact of
- 7 the Fargo diversion project and review retention as an alternative to diversion. The expanded
- 8 study must focus on the impacts in the area outside the area recognized by the army corps of
- 9 engineers for which mitigation is required. The expanded study must include the effect of
- diversion on the price of crop insurance; the sale and rental price of land; the taxable valuation
- of property; and schools, fire protection, townships, and counties from changes in taxable
- 12 valuation. The expanded study must determine the impact on business, communications,
- 13 historical areas, and schools. The study also must determine the buildings and structures that
- 14 will need to be ring diked and estimate the cost of ring dikes, including ring dikes for churches
- 15 and cemeteries. The study must include a plan to provide access to emergency responders in
- 16 case of a flood and the cost of the access. The expanded study must be completed during the
- 17 2015-16 interim and the state water commission shall present a report of the completed
- 18 expanded study to the legislative management's water topics overview committee.
