# 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

# 6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - STATE

# 7 HOSPITAL AND JAMES RIVER CORRECTIONAL CENTER MASTER PLAN. There is

8 appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise

9 appropriated, the sum of <u>\$250,000</u><u>\$125,000</u>, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to

10 the department of human services for the purpose of developing a master plan, in conjunction

11 with the department of corrections and rehabilitation, for the life skills and transition center, the

state hospital, and the James River correctional center, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015,
and ending June 30, 2017. The master plan must address-land:

- <u>1. Land</u> use, vacant structures, and current and projected space needs of the state
   hospital and the James River correctional center. The master plan must also address
   the;
- 17 <u>2. The potential sale of a portion of the state hospital's agricultural land with the proceeds</u>
   18 being used for capital improvement projects at the state hospital-<u>; and</u>
- 19 3. The potential to transfer facilities at the life skills and transition center and the state
   20 hospital to the department of corrections and rehabilitation.

# 21 SECTION 2. DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES - REPORT TO THE LEGISLATIVE

22 **MANAGEMENT.** The department of human services shall provide periodic status reports of the
