- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 19-03.4-03 of the North Dakota Century Code.
- 2 relating to drug paraphernalia; and to provide a penalty.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 19-03.4-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 19-03.4-03. Unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia Penalty.
- 7 A person may not use or possess with intent to use drug paraphernalia to plant, 8 propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce, 9 process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, or conceal, inject, ingest, 10 inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body a controlled substance in violation 11 of chapter 19-03.1. Any person violating this sectionsubsection is guilty of a class C 12 felony if the drug paraphernalia is used, or possessed with intent to be used, to 13 manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, inject, ingest, 14 inhale, or analyze a controlled substance, other than marijuana, classified in 15 schedule I, II, or III of chapter 19-03.1. Otherwise, a violation of this section is
  - 2. A person may not use or possess with the intent to use drug paraphernalia to inject, ingest, inhale, or otherwise induce into the human body a controlled substance, other than marijuana, classified in schedule I, II, or III of chapter 19-03.1. A person violating this subsection is guilty of a class A misdemeanor. If a person previously has been convicted of an offense under this chapter, other than an offense related to marijuana, or an equivalent offense from another court in the United States, a violation of this subsection is a class C felony.
  - 3. A person may not use or possess with intent to use drug paraphernalia to plant, propagate, cultivate, grow, harvest, manufacture, compound, convert, produce,

- process, prepare, test, analyze, pack, repack, store, contain, or conceal marijuana in violation of chapter 19-03.1. A person violating this subsection is guilty of a class A misdemeanor.
- 4. A person may not use or possess with the intent to use drug paraphernalia to ingest,
   inhale, or otherwise introduce into the human body marijuana in violation of
   chapter 19-03.1. A person violating this subsection is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
